

# 2008 Ford Expedition Limited 4x2

## COMPETITIVE PRODUCT FEATURES

### Taking Everyone in Comfort

#### Front-row seats

– Leather-trimmed Captain's Chairs feature 10-way power driver and passenger seats, including power lumbar recline and driver's side memory

✓ Tahoe 2LT's front seats have only 6-way power. Armada LE has 8-way power for the driver seat and only 4-way power for the passenger seat

#### Heated and cooled front seats

– Standard class-exclusive<sup>(1)</sup> heated and cooled front Captain's Chairs for year-round comfort

✓ Not available on Tahoe or Armada

#### Second-row 40/20/40 split bench seat with a class-exclusive<sup>(1)</sup> CenterSlide™ feature

– Allows the center section to be pulled forward almost 11 inches for easy access from the front row

✓ Not available on Tahoe or Armada

#### Third-row PowerFold™ 60/40 split bench seat

– Can fold either or both seatback sections flat to the floor at the touch of a button

✓ Armada's third-row 60/40 split bench seat can fold flat but power operation of the seatbacks requires the LE Technology Package (\$2,400)

✓ Not available on Tahoe

#### Third-row leg room

– All Expedition models feature best-in-class<sup>(1)</sup> third-row leg room

#### Standard Convenience Package

– Includes power adjustable pedals with memory feature, power rear quarter windows, universal garage door opener and Reverse Sensing System

✓ Memory feature with the power adjustable pedals not available on Tahoe 2LT

✓ Power rear quarter windows not available on Tahoe

#### Power sideview mirrors

– Body-color, power-folding, heated sideview mirrors with security approach lamps and integrated turn signals provide greater convenience and security for the driver

✓ Tahoe offers comparable mirrors only on the upscale 3LT and LTZ trim levels

✓ Armada sideview mirrors do not offer security approach lamps

### Superior Handling and Control

#### Independent rear suspension

– Multi-link independent rear suspension design for precise ride control over a variety of surfaces

✓ Tahoe uses a solid axle, non-independent multi-link design with coil springs and shock absorbers

#### Four-wheel disc Anti-lock Braking System (ABS)

– Large vented front and rear disc brakes (13-inch front/13.5-inch rear) with ABS help provide safe, controlled stopping power

✓ Armada's disc brake rotors are smaller in diameter (12.6-inch front/rear) and could provide less stopping power than the Expedition brakes

#### 6-speed automatic transmission

– First-in-class<sup>(1)</sup> 6-speed automatic transmission allows the engine output to be matched more closely with the vehicle driving conditions

✓ Not available on Tahoe or Armada

### Capability for Big Adventures

#### Trailer towing

– Expedition 4x2 models feature a maximum, properly equipped, trailer tow rating of 9200 lbs.

✓ Tahoe 4x2 models are limited to a maximum trailer tow rating of 7500 lbs. when properly equipped, an advantage of 1700 lbs. for Expedition.

✓ Armada 4x2 models are limited to a maximum of 9100 lbs., an advantage of 100 lbs. for Expedition

#### Payload

– Expedition 4x2 models offer a maximum payload capacity of up to 1850 lbs. of passengers and cargo

✓ Tahoe 4x2 models offer up to 1835 lbs. and Armada 4x2 models offer 1592 lbs. of maximum cargo and passenger capacity



### Safety and Security for the Family

#### Safety Canopy® System

– First-in-class<sup>(1)</sup> Safety Canopy System with side curtain airbags helps protect outboard passengers in all three rows of seats

#### Front-seat side-impact airbags

– Provide added thorax protection for the driver and front passenger

✓ Not available on Tahoe

#### AdvanceTrac® with RSC® (Roll Stability Control™)

– AdvanceTrac with class-exclusive<sup>(1)</sup> RSC (Roll Stability Control) utilizes a unique vehicle roll motion sensor to help enhance vehicle control and keep the tires on the ground

✓ Neither Tahoe nor Armada has an electronic stability control system that incorporates a dedicated vehicle roll motion sensor like Expedition

#### NHTSA safety rating

– The 2008 Expedition has again received a five-star frontal crash test rating for the driver and right front passenger from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). That's eight years in a row (2001–2008)

✓ Neither Tahoe nor Armada can match Expedition's history of safety awards

### Quality to Depend On

#### Corrosion warranty

– Rust-through corrosion protection with unlimited mileage is part of Expedition's New Vehicle Limited Warranty

✓ Tahoe rust-through corrosion protection is limited to 100,000 miles

#### Roadside Assistance

– 5-year/60,000-mile Roadside Assistance

✓ Armada offers Roadside Assistance only as part of an optional, extra-cost extended warranty program
